Some feelings that Support the LIE

- Our View of God is often determined by our relationship with the men in our lives (especially our father)
- Our perception of God can be positively or negatively shaped by men
- If your Father was absent, critical, abusive, overbearing, unable to express love...
 - Seeing God as your Father may make you cringe
 - Your may find it difficult to trust God
 - You may be afraid of God
 - Our Great Earthly Fathers do not compare to GOD




He who disdains instruction despises his own soul, But he who heeds rebuke gets understanding.





And God *is* able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all *things,* may have an abundance


